

Base2Summit Policy on Tobacco, Alcohol and Cannabis

1. Tobacco use on the Base2Summit grounds or during any B2S off site activity is prohibited. If you need to use tobacco products, please let the staff know before you walk off the property.
2. Alcohol consumption is not allowed. During the Base2Summit week, we are committed to the tenants of wellness and adventure; alcohol is inconsistent with those values.
3. Although the State of Michigan has legalized recreational cannabis it is NOT federally legal in the US.
 - It is not advisable to fly with cannabis as TSA can refer you to local law enforcement, if found, regardless of if you have a medical cannabis card/prescription.
 - **No sharing.** Please do not share your medical cannabis with fellow campers. This includes oils, edibles, tinctures, etc. Some participants may have never used cannabis and could have an adverse reaction. Just as it is prohibited to share any prescription medication with your housemates, sharing cannabis is not allowed.
 - If you need to use cannabis, in any form, for medical purposes, please do so in private.
4. Make sure to go over your cannabis prescription/use, along with any other medications with a B2S staff member. It is necessary to understand your entire health picture to ensure the safety and wellbeing of you and your fellow campers.
